The base model, a 2.7 cost just \$450,000 while the bigger brother, the 3.4S comes in at \$550,000. Performance wise, 0-100 km/h is 4.8s and top end is 277kmh. Good turn of speed. What is definitely an improvement is the roof. Electrically deployed, it moves up and down smoothly and quietly. The previous model's early versions had a horror roof mechanism. I have yet to take a test drive, but if the 991 vs. 997 Carrera improvement can be achieved, then I am sure it is a much better car all round, especially dynamically

Afternoon party with a twist. PCM were invited to this. One word. Different. However, we are not at liberty to say who was dumped into the pool








6.0 Super GT (Japan GT)
